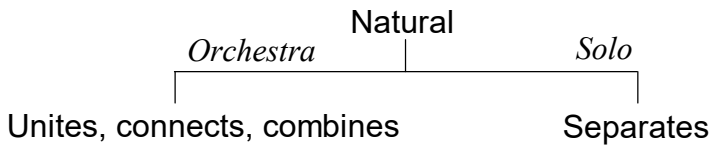
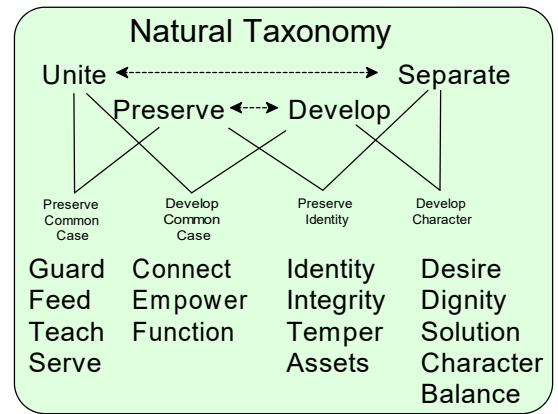


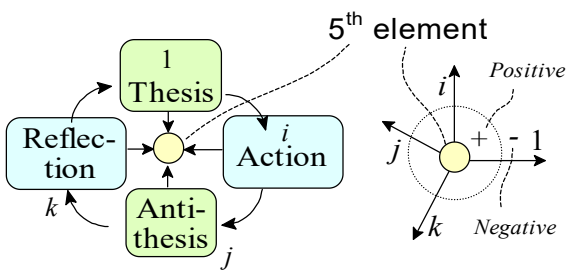
1 "Natural" Taxonomy of Positive Outcomes

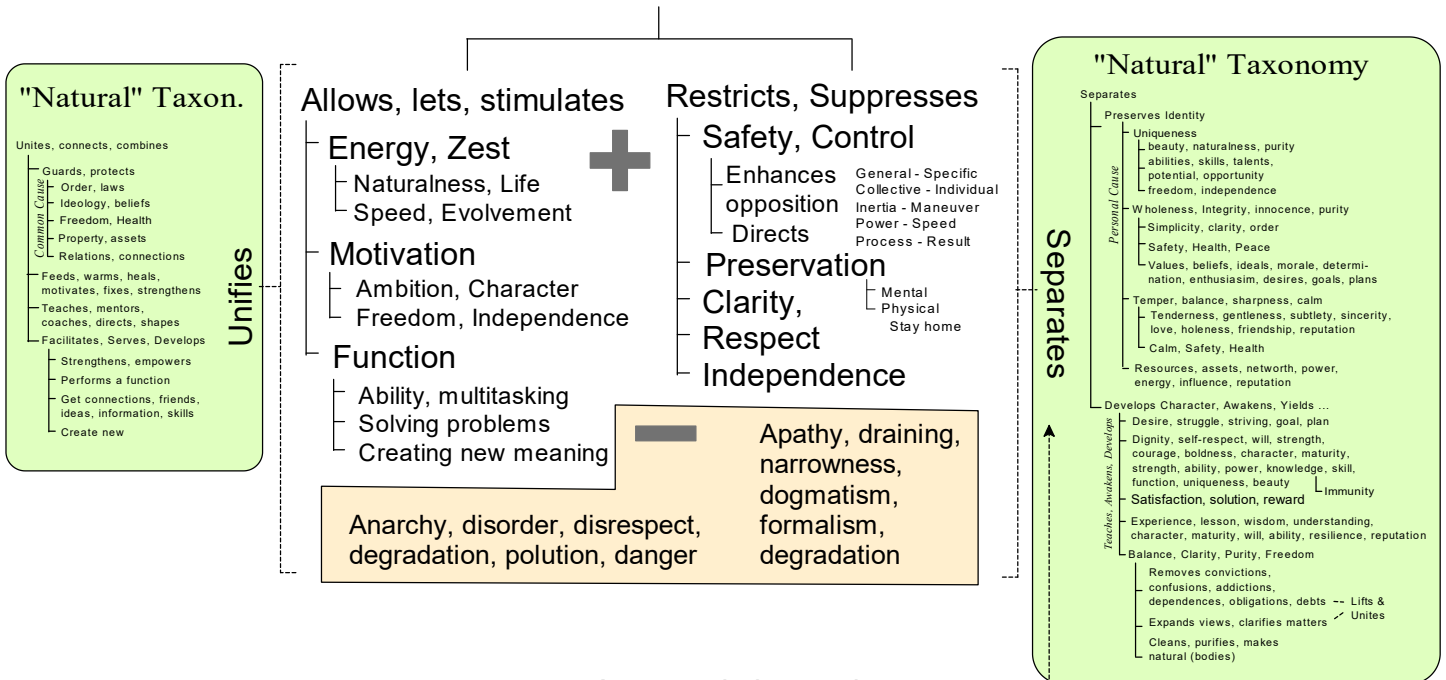
- Personal Cause**

2 "Legislative" Taxonomy of Positive Outcomes



"Legislative" taxonomy is more practical in a short-term, but "natural" taxonomy is more beneficial in a long run

Any restriction makes an opposition slightly more brutal than it was before. Hence, it separates rather than unites

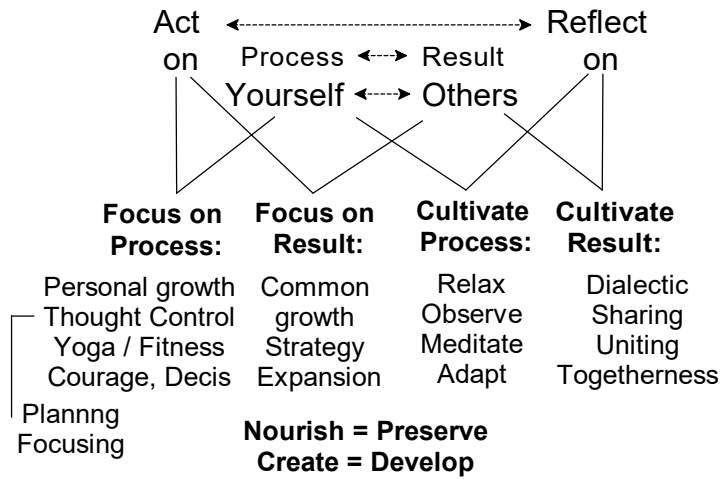
Restrict speed, mass, accuracy - increase power, maneuverability, generality, but in a way that is difficult to control

Decrease spontaneity ~ increase safety, until uncontrollable opposition creates new problems
